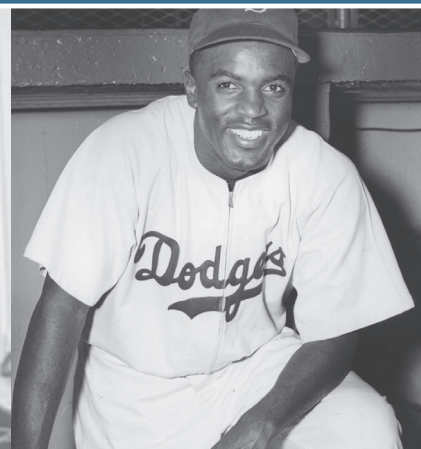

Jackie Robinson Foundation (JRF) is a national, not-for-profit, organization founded in 1973 as a vehicle to perpetuate the memory of Jackie Robinson through the advancement of higher education among underserved populations. Uniquely, JRF provides generous four-year college scholarships in conjunction with a comprehensive set of tools and opportunities to disadvantaged students of color to ensure their success in college and to develop leadership potential. JRF's strategic combination of financial assistance and support services results consistently in a nearly 100% college graduation rate.

Foundation at a Glance

\$50 million distributed in total program support;
\$22 million in direct scholarship aid.

Currently, 220 students, attending 92 different colleges and universities, are enrolled in JRF's four-year program

Students have attended over 225 colleges and universities in 43 states and the District of Columbia
1,400 students have participated in the Scholarship Program
